Article III: Membership and dues (Wording must be verbatim; except special interest councils) <u>Section 1</u> – Eligibility: Membership in the council shall be open to all persons engaged in the teaching or supervision of reading at any school level, to parents, and to all others interested in the purpose of the council.

Section 5 – ILA: Council in good standing if Presidents are ILA members		
Article IV: Officers (Includes List of offices) Section 1 – Officers: Note that the President must be a member of ILA.

(number depends on number of officers) Term of Office: Terms, time of assuming office, duties of officers must be outlined; wording, length of terms are discretionary, except in the case of the treasurer. In addition to listing the regular duties of the treasurer, include the following which must read verbatim: 1. All income must be in council accounts approved by the Board and council body. No money can be in a separate account for a subgroup or committee of council. 2. Two people MUST be on the signature card for the council account. 3. There MUST be two signatures on all vouchers for payment of bills. 4. Each council account MUST be audited each year. 5. An accounting of all spending and income is to be reported at every meeting.

Section 3 – Mode of Election: Election procedure must be described and provision made for write-in or floor nominations.	
Section 4 – Reporting: Newly elected officers reported to IRC using the provided forms by April 15th	
<u>Section 5</u> – Term of office begins July 1; follows terms set in Article IV, Section 2.
