



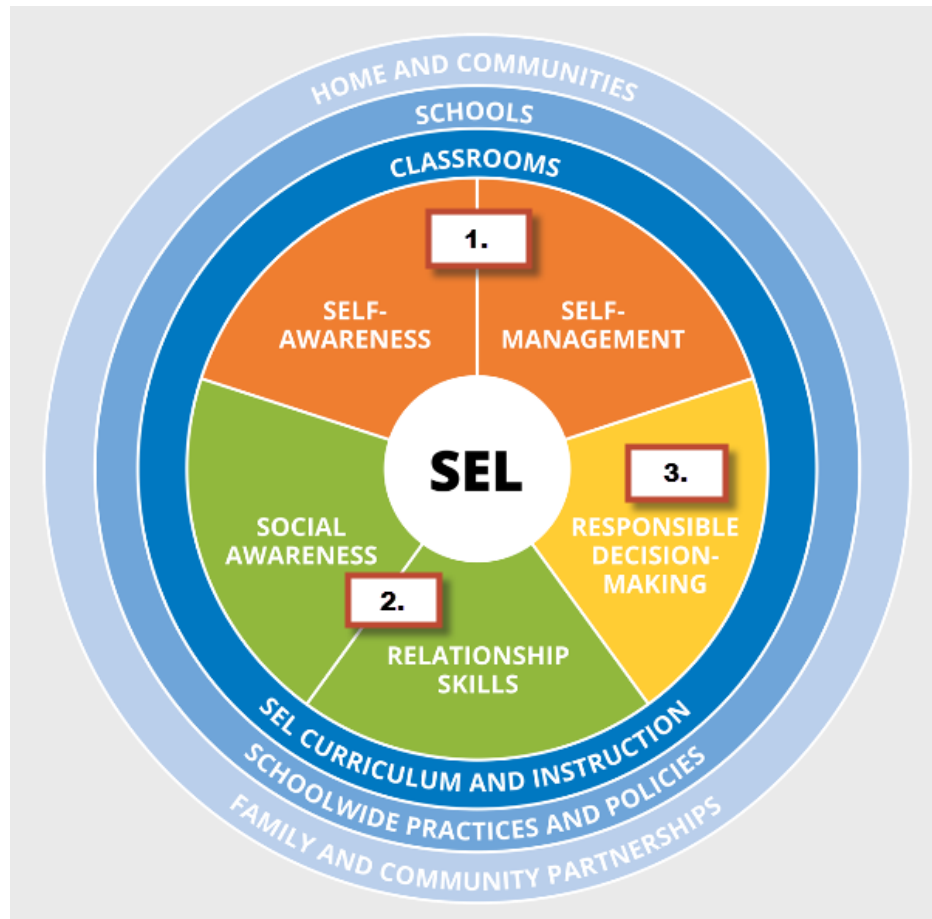

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## About this Bibliography

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I have arranged the books in this bibliography, 1<sup>st</sup> column in alphabetical order by book *title*, author, publisher and copyright date of each book. Educators can use these books in varied teaching situations such as read-alouds, shared reading experiences, writing mentor texts as well as to help students make social and emotional connections with the traits of some of the story characters.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> column, *Special Info*\*, provides additional resources for utilizing many of the books. The coding system is located and linked at the bottom of each page. The resource include:

- 1: [Teachingbooks.net](http://Teachingbooks.net) is a subscription service by school. It is a valuable literacy website. Their mission and quest are to “empower every reader to, connect deeply with a book, gain new insights and understandings from the author, and thoroughly experience the joy of reading.” (Teachingbooks.net) They have curated and vetted a collection of instructional materials and resources to assist educators with books that “reflect diverse cultural experiences, interests, and ability levels. It is a site to obtain resources, for development of contextual knowledge and educational relevance.”

- 2: [Teaching Children Philosophy](#), The Book Modules “will introduce you to the understanding of philosophy in picture books and suggest questions to help educators initiate a philosophical discussion with children”. Although this site can be used for ALL students, it will be of special interest to those educators that address the needs of advanced and gifted literacy learners.
- 3. 6+1 Traits of Writing. Many of the books contain traits that can be used as a mentor text for the teaching of writing. To support many of these books I have provided ideas as to specific traits the text may represent. These are only suggestions but since educators are often utilizing books as models for writing, this correlation assists in demonstrating for students how authors develop their writing craft. Abbreviations for the Traits are: (SF=Sentence Fluency, V=Voice, I=Ideas, WC=Word Choice, O=Organization, C=Conventions, P=Presentation).
- 4. [Social Justice Books](#) is a web resource that supports multicultural and culturally relevant books for all learners. The link takes you to a list of texts in alphabetical order that have been reviewed with a lens on three categories: Recommended, Recommended with a Caveat, and Not Recommended. As you begin to add to your library and classroom collection of multi-cultural and culturally relevant texts, the “Guide for Selecting Anti-Bias Children’s Books” as well as the reviews provided for books, help align to students learning needs as well as bridge research findings that share the educational and social/emotional benefits. When students see themselves in books that provide diverse points of view and topics of interest motivation and engagement, reading becomes more meaningful and deeply enhanced.

The graphic above is from the [Collaborative for Academic, Social, and Emotional Learning](#) (CASEL Standards). It represents the foundations and principals of the [Illinois Social and Emotional Learning Standards](#) (IL SEL).

The 3<sup>rd</sup> column represents the correlation of the books to the IL SEL. They are referenced in the bibliography and in the informational graphic as Goals 1, 2, and 3. The IL SEL Standards are the hallmark of this bibliography. To further understand the IL SEL Standards, please consider accessing the *Comprehensive System of Support Charts* divided into grades [K-3](#), [4-5](#) and [6-8](#). These valuable resource charts are provided by the Illinois State Board of Education Content Specialist. Their comprehensive [Illinois Literacy in Action](#) Website provides a host of valuable information to support literacy learning.

I have also included in the 4<sup>th</sup> column the CASEL Standards categories as well as additional aligned competencies that provide an overarching categorical theme. These competencies are found in the [Indiana SEL Standards](#) and I felt they provided an expansion of ideas and themes to support students.

SEL Competencies:

- Self-Awareness/Insightful Thinking: the ability to know your emotions and how they affect your thought and actions. Gaining insight is an important skill for building self-confidence, self-esteem, and empathy for others. Insight helps student recognize their own strengths and areas of growth.
- Self -Management/Regulation: the ability to recognize and manage one’s emotions. Regulation skills build positive self-control, positive self-discipline, and impulse control.
- Relationship Skills/Collaboration: the ability to work well with others including group and teamwork environment. Collaboration works to build positive communication and conflict management skills.

- Social Awareness/Connections: the ability to have strong social awareness, giving students the ability to take the perspectives of others and empathize with people of diverse backgrounds and cultures.
- Responsible Decision Making/Critical Thinking: the ability to make constructive choices and understand metacognitive strategies to enhance learning. Critical thinking skills build responsible decision-making, analytical, and critical inquiry skills which are necessary to approach learning from an innovative, creative, multicultural and ethical lens.
- Growth Mindset: the ability to demonstrate cognitive flexibility and a willingness to learn. Developing mindset is a critical learning skill for building perseverance, adaptability, self-discovery, resilience, and the ability to receive and give constructive feedback.

The 5<sup>th</sup> column, *Lexile*® Levels, as well as 6<sup>th</sup> column, *Fountas and Pinnell* quantitative reading levels, are provided as points of reference only. Selecting texts for students should not just be based on a number or a letter qualifier. I have added these to help educators consider books that may be appropriate based the three text complexity indicators that match students with books. After a quantitative measure has been established for book selection the qualitative measure attributes for literary and informational texts are found on the linked rubrics. The third part of text complexity triangulation is Reader and Task considerations. The triangulation of text is part of the Illinois Common Core Standards for English Language Arts. Again, the Lexile Measure and F & P help us better understand only one part of text selection process for students.
